Denise graduated from the University of Detroit with a bachelor's in management information systems in 1989. Denise believed in lifelong learning and went on to receive her MBA from the University of Dallas and a Master's degree in Organizational Development from American University. Denise held notable leadership roles across various prominent organizations, including American Express, Accenture, Verizon and the IRS. She is recognized as a thought leader in her field, focusing on developing, implementing, and managing solutions that enhance both technology and business processes. Denise was devoted to her daughter, active in community engagement and loved to travel to meet new people and experience new adventures. She always had a kind word to share and provided support to those in need.

#### The Awards

#### Who is Eligible?

Women aged 16-19 years and living or studying in the Dallas area at the time the application is submitted to the Zonta Club of Dallas and demonstrate evidence of the following, are eligible to apply.

- Currently attending high school in the Dallas area and on track to graduate at end of Spring 2026 semester
- Confirmed attendance in a business program with major field of specialization in accounting, economics, finance, business management, business technology, information technology, marketing, operations management, human resources management, international business, or entrepreneurship at an accredited university for the Fall 2026 semester
- Excellent Academic Achievement
- Experience in local or student clubs/organizations, especially those involved with helping others learn
- Volunteer leadership achievements
- Knowledge of Zonta International and its programs

Previous scholarship recipients are not eligible to apply. Applicants for the 2026 Zonta Club of Dallas Denise Kirkman Young Women in Business Leadership Award may not also apply for the 2026 Zonta Club of Dallas Ruth Maddox Young Women in STEM Award or the 2026 Zonta Young Women in Leadership Award.

#### **Application Requirements**

- Completion of the official application
- Verification of current enrollment by school official.
- Two confidential recommendations from adults, not related to the applicant, such as teachers, school officials or community leaders.

Supporting documentation not requested will not be considered. All applications and supporting information become the property of Zonta Club of Dallas. Zonta Club of Dallas has final authority over any aspect of the Awards.


